Description: Eagle-SWS supports Florida Power & Light (FP&L) on a daily basis with respect to the OSRO Requirements. This support includes scheduling facility inspections of spill and containment equipment, restoring and upgrading spill and containment equipment, monthly operations of spill response equipment to ensure readiness, facilitating table top exercises, and participating in spill boom deployment exercises at FP&L facilities.

Eagle-SWS has met all criteria to qualify as a responder for all classifications: MMPD (Maximum Most Probable Discharge); WCD 1, 2, 3 (Worst Case Discharge) Tiers 1, 2 & 3 (the combination of response resources and the times within which the resources must be capable of arriving on-scene to meet WCD resource requirements, as defined in 33CFR154.1020 and 33CFR155.1025).

Eagle-SWS has service centers strategically located throughout the various Captains of the Port (COTP) zones in the Southeast (in Florida – Jacksonville, Miami, Tampa; in Georgia – Atlanta; in Alabama – Mobile; in Kentucky – Paducah) and the sub-ports (in Florida – Jacksonville/Port Canaveral; in Alabama – Mobile/Port of Panama City, FL).
